Bombay Convention & Exhibition Centre (BCEC) is the largest and permanent exhibition centre, in the private sector, in India and was set up in 1991. BCEC has hosted several prestigious International trade fairs/ exhibitions ever since.

The centre is ideally situated along the Western Express Highway in Goregaon, within 10 minutes from airports, walking distance to train stations and a 20 minute drive from the heart of the city. There are numerous hotels, entertainment activities, retail shopping & sightseeing spots in close proximity.

By car

Tourist taxi: Rates vary according to the car.

UBER and OLA: This cab service is very convenient and can be booked via the smartphone application.

Imported cars: Rs. 1700/- for 8 hrs or 80 km, extra Rs. 17/- per km or Rs. 110/- per hour.

Metered taxi (non-a/c): Rs. 22 for first 1.5 km. Additional fare to be paid as per tariff card available with the driver.

Meru taxi (a/c): Rs. 20 for first 1 km and Rs. 14 for subsequent Kms.

By auto rickshaw

Rs. 18 for first 1.5 km. Additional fare to be paid as per tariff, card available with the driver.

By train
